- **3.** To advance skills by providing a forum for qualified artists to exhibit, present, or perform their artistic works through participation in such events.
- **4.** To promote health by providing artists with disabilities with appropriate facilities and services adapted to accommodate their specific needs.
- **5.** To undertake activities ancillary and incidental to the attainment to the above charitable purposes.
